Seventh-day Adventists Believe....

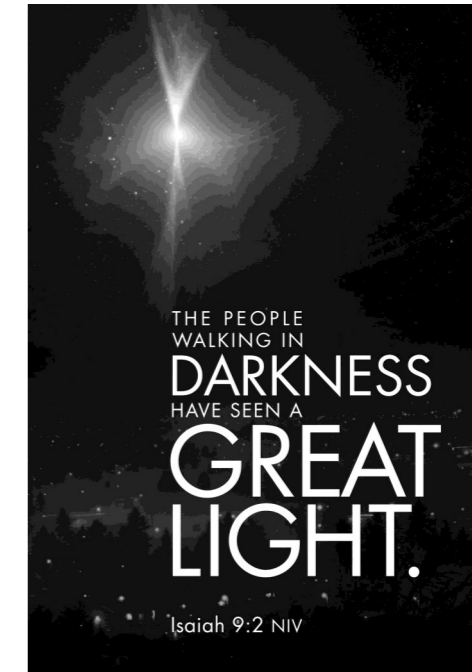
In one God - Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Heb. 1:1-3; Matt. 3:16-17; 28:19.
