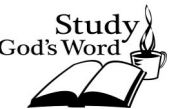

## Seventh-day Adventists Believe....

In one God - Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Heb. 1:1-3; Matt. 3:16-17; 28:19.  
Jesus Christ, the Divine Son of God is our Savior. John 1: 1-3.  
The Holy Spirit, the Divine Comforter leads sinners to repentance. John 16:7-16.  
The Bible is God's inspired Word. 2 Timothy 3: 16-17.  
In regeneration and the new birth, through belief in and acceptance of the gospel. John 3:1-7, 16-17; II Cor. 5:17.

By reason of His death Christ offers the free gift of His righteousness to all who accept Him by faith. Rom. 4: 3-5.  
Salvation is by grace alone, it comes as a gift of God, received by faith and not through any merit of the sinner. Eph. 2: 8-9.  
The Ten Commandments is the standard of righteousness by which all will be judged and which all Christians are commanded to obey. James 2:10-12; Ex. 20:3-17.  
God created the world in six literal days and established the Seventh-day Sabbath as a memorial of creation, therefore all people are obligated to keep it holy. Ex. 20: 8-11; Acts 13:14, 42.  
God promises to bless us as we freely return tithes and offerings to support the work of the gospel. Lev. 27:32; Mal. 3:10; 1 Cor. 9:13,14.  
In baptism by immersion. Mk. 1:9, 10; Rom. 6:3-5.
